A model for Cleaning up Conversations

```

    graph TD
      A[Set the frame  
Brief history, reasons, goal, roles] --> B[Starting Q  
What would you like to have happen [with these frames in mind]?]
      B --> C[Develop Cleanly  
What kind of... is that...? etc.]
      C --> D[Frames  
Repeat main points & add your ideas, suggestions or frames]
      D --> E["(Starting) Q  
With all that, what would you like to have happen now?  
Or  
What's that like for you?"]
      E --> F[Develop Cleanly  
What kind of... is that...? etc.]
      F --> G[Rounding up  
Summarise and agree on actions]
      G --> H[Action]
      H -.-> A

Make sure you ask about what someone might like more of!

      B --> C((Develop))
      C --> D[Repeat & add your views]
      D --> E[With all that, WWYLTHH now? Or What's that like for you?]
      E --> F((Develop))
      F --> G[Summarise and agree actions]
      G --> H[Actions]
  
```
